Scholarly Article Review Checklist

- ☐ Is the research original, significant, and clearly written?
- ☐ Does the abstract clearly summarize the aims, methods, findings, and conclusions?
- ☐ Is the research problem clearly defined and well-contextualized?
- ☐ Are the key literature and the study's contributions clearly presented?
- ☐ Are the methods sufficiently detailed for replication and properly cited?
- ☐ Are new approaches justified, and is the statistical analysis appropriate?
- ☐ Are the data clearly presented and logically interpreted?
- ☐ Are limitations acknowledged, and are the contributions meaningful?
- ☐ Are the conclusions supported by the results without overstatement?
- ☐ Are references, figures, and tables accurate and clearly presented?
